## **Daily Lesson Plan (RPH)**

**Subject:** English

Form: 5

**Theme:** IT'S PERSONAL

**Topic:** Collocation **Duration:** 1 hour

### **Learning Standards**

1. **Content Standard:** 5.1.1 - Understanding and using collocations appropriately in context.

2. **Learning Standard:** 5.1.1(a) - Students will be able to identify and use common collocations in writing and speaking tasks.

## **Learning Objectives**

By the end of the lesson, students will be able to:

- 1. Identify at least 10 commonly used collocations in English.
- 2. Use at least 5 collocations correctly in spoken and written sentences.
- 3. Utilize the **Collocation Hub** application to find and understand the use of collocations.

### **Prior Knowledge**

Students have previously learned about verbs, adjectives, and nouns.

### **Teaching Aids**

- 1. PowerPoint Presentation on collocations
- 2. Collocation Hub application at https://collhub.theexceptionalx.com/
- 3. Whiteboard and marker

#### **Learning Activities**

#### 1. Set Induction (5 minutes)

- The teacher shows several sentences containing collocations using PowerPoint.
- o Students are asked to identify and guess the collocations in the sentences.

# 2. Step 1: Explanation and Demonstration (10 minutes)

- The teacher explains the definition and importance of collocations in English.
- Examples of collocations are given (e.g., make a decision, take a break, catch a cold).
- The teacher introduces the **Collocation Hub** application and how to use it to find collocations.
- The teacher demonstrates how to use the application practically.

# 3. Step 2: Student-Centered Group Activity (30 minutes)

- o Students are divided into small groups.
- o Each group is given access to the Collocation Hub application.

- Group tasks:
  - 1. Find at least 10 collocations using the Collocation Hub application.
  - 2. Create sentences using the collocations found.
  - 3. Prepare a brief presentation about the collocations and sentences they have created.
- The teacher moves around the classroom to monitor, assist, and answer any questions from the student groups.

### 4. Step 3: Presentation and Sharing (10 minutes)

- o Each group presents their work to the class.
- Other students provide feedback and ask questions about the presentations of other groups.

### 5. Closure (5 minutes)

- The teacher summarizes the topic learned and the importance of using collocations correctly.
- o The teacher gives praise and positive feedback on the students' efforts.
- The teacher encourages students to continue using the Collocation Hub application in their learning.

#### Assessment

- 1. Observation during group activities.
- 2. Evaluation of group presentations.
- 3. Oral feedback during sharing.

#### Reflection

- Did the students correctly identify and use collocations?
- How did the students demonstrate their understanding of this topic through activities and presentations?
- Did the Collocation Hub application help students understand and find collocations?
